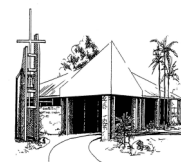

Greetings in the name of Jesus Christ

Don't be impatient

'Let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.' **James 1:4 NKJV**

Just because it hasn't happened yet doesn't mean it won't, or that God has changed His mind. While you are waiting-God is working. The timing may not be right for Him to get the ultimate glory and you the ultimate benefit. That's why James writes: 'Let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.' Impatience is a sign of immaturity. Have you noticed that children can't wait for anything? But a wise parent knows what's best. God sets His watch to accomplish His purpose, not ours. Paul writes: 'We know that all things work...according to His purpose.' (See Romans 8:28). When you clearly understand God's purpose you won't permit things that are contrary to it, including hurry and worry. You'll also know how to allocate your time, your effort and your money-where to go and where not to go.

God says, 'I make known the end from the beginning.' (Isaiah 46:10 NIV) First God sets the goal, then He determines the steps that lead to it. And what are we supposed to do while we are waiting? Listen: 'Though the fig tree does not bud and there are no grapes on the vines, though the olive crop fails and the fields produce no food, though there are no sheep in the pen and no cattle in the stalls, yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will be joyful in God my Saviour.' (Habakkuk 3:17-18 NIV)

Begin praising the Lord today for what He's going to do for you-because He absolutely will come through for you!

IMPORTANT - Show Diner News!

The Edmonton Pony Club is hosting a state wide event at the show grounds from the 24th Sept to 28th Sept - i.e. the first week of the September school holidays.

Our Show Diner Committee has been invited to run a canteen on the Tuesday to Friday of that week. This would involve a basic breakfast, morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea – all take-away style. We would keep the menu simple i.e. scones, sandwiches, pies/pasties, chips, hamburgers, hot and cold drinks, ice-creams, etc.

The Club anticipates an event attendance of 180 to 220 riders plus their families. (The regional event our committee catered for 11 years ago had an attendance of 150 riders plus their families). Some will camp at the grounds and others in commercial accommodation.

We would be the only out-let at the grounds but predicting patronage is guess work. Delivering information/menu flyers to the organizers and around the grounds would be essential.

As our site is covered by an annual license fee and there would be no entrance pass costs, the overheads would be lower than for our Show effort. The funds would be distributed on the same basis as for the Show.

We feel we would require a minimum of 15 people a day, divided into a morning shift of 6.30am – 11.30 am and an afternoon shift of 11.30am – 4.30pm; plus the preparation and clean-up working bees.

The Diner Committee's very firm view is that we decline the offer unless our congregations feel they will be able to support it. It is appreciated that not everyone can make a commitment this far away from the event but a positive response would allow us to submit a proposal to the Pony Club.

Our first Committee meeting for the year is Tues 21st February at 5.15pm. We would appreciate your feedback **BEFORE 14th FEBRUARY.**

A reply by email would be very much appreciated.
